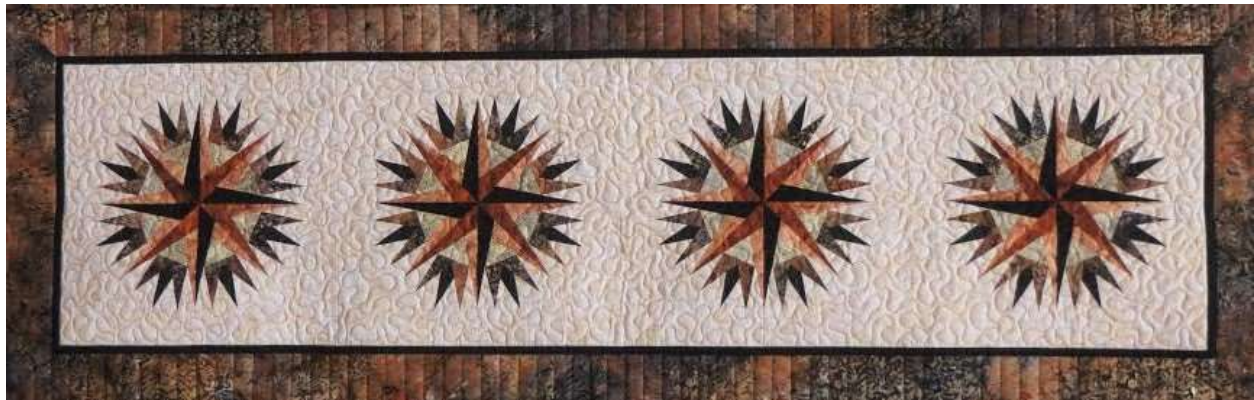


## Compass Rose Table Runner

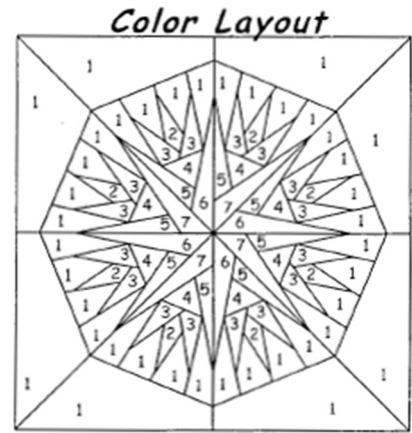


Finished size: 22" x 69"

### Supplies:

- **Quiltworx Compass Rose table runner pattern, \$26**
- **Sewing Machine with basic supplies** (scissors, ripper, thread, bobbins, pins, power cord, etc)
- **Open toe (applique) foot and/or 1/4" foot** - you need good visibility of the needle as you sew on the foundation paper lines
- **Fabrics** - pre-cut strips per following directions
- **Cutting mat** - 12" x 18" is a good size to bring
- **Rotary cutter with a new blade** - 60mm (the big one) is my favorite but any size will work
- **Medium sized rotary cutting ruler** - 6" x 12" or similar
- **6" or 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler** (yellow or pink) - Either size works for this pattern. If you are buying one, get the 12" as it is more versatile.
- **Fabric glue pen with 2 refills** (i.e., Sewline, Fons and Porter)
- **Microtex sewing machine needles** (Size 70/10)
- **7 1-gallon zip bags**
- **~150 Jumbo plastic-coated paper clips**

**Fabric Requirements:** Yardages needed for the project are shown in the table below. Fabric numbers are keyed to the Color Layout diagram to the right. Before cutting your fabrics, I recommend you starch and press them. I like to use Faultless Heavy Starch, Fresh Lavender scent. Best Press is another great option. It is also helpful to tape a swatch of each fabric next to the appropriate fabric number below.

3		2-3/8	Binding**

**Pre-Class Preparation:** I have condensed the preparation instructions from the pattern to just what you need to have prepared before class.

**Fabric preparation:**

- Label your 7 - 1 gallon zip bags #1 through #7.
- Cut your fabric per the table below and place in the zip bag as follows:

\*\*Cut after blocks are finished. Not needed for class.

**Foundation papers preparation:**

- Your foundation papers are printed on newsprint in your pattern. There are 32 identical foundation papers for this pattern (Unit A).
- Open the newsprint and, in a single layer, trim 1/8" around the outside edge of all 32 foundation papers. Clip the papers together in 4 groups of 8 and place in Bag #7.

### Template Layout Sheet preparation:

- Template layout sheets are used to efficiently cut out the fabric pieces. Some contain all the same shaped piece; others contain a combination of pieces. Template layout sheets are also printed on the newsprint in your pattern.
- Open the newsprint and, in a single layer, trim along the outside edge of the template layout sheets identified below.
- Place each template layout sheet in the zip bag indicated below:

### Template preparation:

- Templates are used for cutting exact shapes. There are two templates in this pattern (Background Template AL and AR).
- Open the newsprint and, in a single layer, trim along the outside edge of the templates AL and AR.
- Place these templates in Bag #7.

**Note:** This pre-class preparation will assist you (and me) in making the most progress during class. I will start my instruction with the assumption that this preparation work is completed. I understand that sometimes life gets in the way and we are not always as prepared for class as we want to be. If that happens to you, please don't let that stop you from coming to class! I will get you up to speed as quickly as I can. Just know that I will keep the rest of the class moving forward first.
