KIDS SUMMER KWILT KAMP

A beginner level class

If your child wants to learn how to sew and you don't have the time or knowledge, this class is for them! We teach students the basic fundamentals of the sewing machine and how to sew a straight seam. (We use our sewing machines – please don't bring yours).

Kids choose their own fabric (front and backing) for this class. Fabrics for the front of the quilt will need to be purchased and cut before class. If you wish, a teacher will cut for you for a \$5 fee. **If we are cutting for you, we will need the fabric at least one week before class begins.** If you do your own cutting, be sure you cut accurately for your kids' success.

Graduates of Kid's Kamp will choose their own fabrics for this quilt and pillowcase. We will build on previously learned skills and aim toward an accurate ¼" seam allowance and rows that are the same length. They will also read a simple pattern to determine the order pieces are sewn together.

Kids choose their own fabric for this class (front and backing). Fabric for the front of the quilt will need to be purchased and cut before class. If you wish, a teacher will cut for you for a \$5 fee. **If we are cutting for you, we will need the fabric at least one week before class begins.** If you do your own cutting, be sure you cut accurately for your kids' success.

Emoji faces are everywhere! Now you can make one of your own on a special pillow. There are several choices of eyes and mouths so you can mix and match to get just the one you want. The face is fused and then appliqued. Sew and stuff the pillow and you have a fun Emoji just for you. There is no pre-cutting required for this class. You bring the background for the pillow (it doesn't have to be yellow) and felt (white, black and red) will be provided by the teacher. Patterns are also provided. It will be such fun to see what Emoji faces will be there to join our class!



3rd Times the Charm - Magic Pillow Quilt

It's a pillow – NO - it's a quilt – NO - it's a Magic Pillow Quilt! This project features an Ohio Star pillow that is attached to a quilt. When the quilt is folded and tucked inside, it transforms into a pillow. What fun to take to a sleep-over or on a trip. Choose your own fabrics to make a stripy quilt and pillow for an item that is uniquely your own. In addition we will make a cute quilted, zippered bag. What fun! Kids in this class **MUST** have successfully completed 2nd time around.

Fabrics must be cut to size before class. If you wish, a teacher will cut for you. The cutting fee is \$5. We will need the fabric at least one week before class begins. If you do your own cutting, be sure you cut accurately as a quilter cuts or the pieces will not fit together.

3rd Times A Charm - A Slice of Summer Quilt

We are excited to offer this quilt for experienced 3rd year students! A Slice of Summer is shown with fun black & white text background fabrics or solid color backgrounds. Both are fun colorful examples of this happy quilt. Students learn how to create circle templates, apply soft fusible, machine stitch appliqué curves and follow an intermediate-level pattern. Students will learn to nestle intersecting corners and increase quilting skills. Students will select 8 background fabrics & 8 slice fabrics, as well as backing fabric. A class kit (\$59) will include pattern, appliqué/quilting thread, 2 yards of soft fuse, circle templates, twin size batting & basting spray. See the supply list for more detailed information. 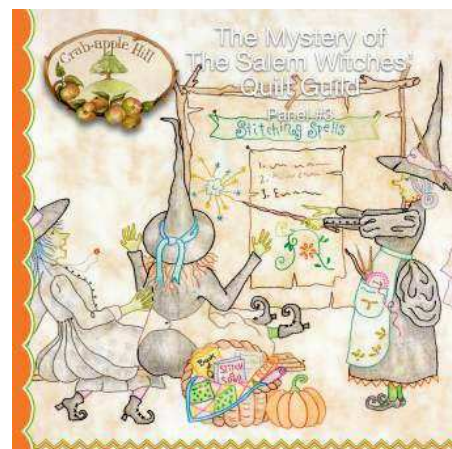
