Your sewing machine must be in good working condition and you must know how to use and sew on the machine you bring to class. If you need to borrow a machine while at class, please put your name on the Sewing Machine List for the Basic Quiltmaking Class.

Please plan on arriving 15 minutes prior to the class starting and be ready to sew when class starts.

This class is designed for the person who knows nothing about quilting, yet also provides helpful hints and tips for those looking to improve their present skills. We start right at the beginning by looking at Fabrics, Color and Notions, then moving on to the correct usage of the rotary cutter, rulers and how to master that quarter-inch seam used in quilt making. You only need to know how to sew a straight stitch. The class specializes in individual attention and hands-on training. You will learn how to make Piano Keys Bricks, Checkerboards, Half-Square Triangles and Flying Geese to use in a quilt. There is some homework with this class, so it is recommended that the student have access to a sewing machine at home.

This class is to teach you to piece a quilt top and does not cover quilting or binding.

Fabrics: This class will be making Sarah's Sampler from the book Graphic Mix pages 6 – 8 Purchase 16 fat quarters – A Fat Quarter is half of a half yard. Usually 18" x 22". Choose a variety of medium and small prints, lights and darks that contrast with the main background color. 3 ½ yards of a solid or tone on tone print for background.

Please purchase 100% cotton fabrics from a quilting store. Please no rayon's, silks, polyesters, velvets, canvas, home dec fabrics etc. It must be 100% cotton fabric from a quilt store. Please no fabrics from Hancocks, Walmart or Joanns.
