

Indian Summer

Finished size: 64" x 73"



Supplies:

- Quiltworx Indian Summer 2015 pattern, \$44
- Sewing Machine with basic supplies (scissors, ripper, thread, bobbins, pins, power cord, etc)
- Open toe (applique) foot and/or 1/4" foot – you need good visibility of the needle as you sew on the foundation paper lines
- Fabrics - pre-cut per following directions
- Cutting mat - 12" x 18" is a good size to bring
- Rotary cutter with a new blade - 60mm (the big one)
- Medium sized rotary cutting ruler - 6" x 12" or similar
- 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler (yellow or pink)
- Purple Thang
- Tweezers - I like Martelli Angled Pin-Point tweezers
- Fabric glue pen with 2 refills (i.e., Sewline, Fons and Porter)
- Fold template: 3" x 12" piece of template plastic or card stock
- Microtex Size 70/10 sewing machine needles - (do not work for Featherweights)
- 4 @ 2-gallon zip bags
- ~150-200 Jumbo plastic-coated paper clips

Fabric Requirements: Yardages needed for the project are:

- 1/6 yard of 21 Light to Medium Lights (used in center blocks)
- 1/3 yard of 21 Dark to Medium Dark (used in center blocks and in pieced border)
- 2 yards for inner border and binding (not needed for class)
- 4-1/2 yards for backing (not needed for class)

Pre-Class Preparation: Please complete the following prior to coming to class.

Zip bag preparation: Label your zip bags #1 through #4. It can also helpful to include the pattern name or an abbreviation (IS for Indian Summer) on the label. (NOTE: The pattern calls for 2 bags, however, we will use 4 bags.)

Fabric preparation: Press and starch your fabrics, if desired. I like to use Faultless Heavy Starch, Lavender scent. Best Press is another great option.

Fabric	Cut	Put in Bag
Light to Medium Lights	1 @ 5" x 42" strip from each of your 21 fabrics	#1
Dark to Medium Dark	1 @ 5" x 42" strip from each of your 21 fabrics	#1
	1 @ 6-1/2" x 42" strips from each of your 21 fabrics	#4

Newsprint preparation: Unfold the 13 newsprint pages from your pattern. Trim 1/8" around all the units (freehand or with a rotary cutting ruler) and place in the Zip bags indicated below.

Unit CB foundation papers	84	Clip into 3 groups of 14 and place one group into Bags #1 - #3
Unit CB template layout sheet	All	Divide into 3 groups and place one group into Bags #1 - #3
Unit DR foundation papers	12	#4
Unit DL foundation papers	12	#4

Temp DL	All	#4
Unit CP foundation papers	2	#4
