

Twinkle Star

Finished size: 38" x 38"

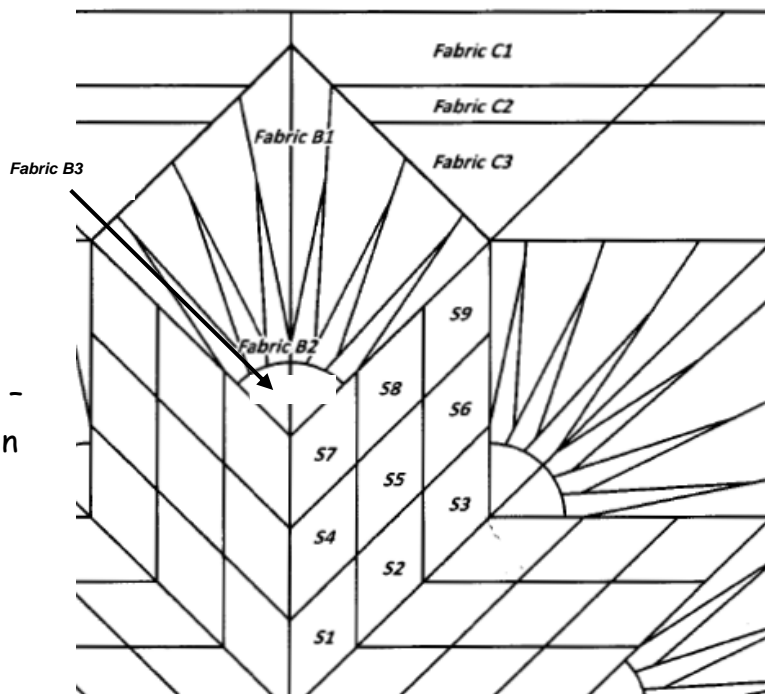


Supplies:

- **Quiltworx Twinkle Star pattern**, \$27 available from Oklahoma Quiltworks
- **Fabrics** - prepared per following directions
- **Sewing Machine with basic supplies** (scissors, ripper, thread, bobbins, pins, power cord, etc)
- **Open toe (applique) foot and/or 1/4" foot** - you need good visibility of the needle as you sew on the foundation paper lines
- **Cutting mat** - 12" x 18" is a good size to bring
- **Rotary cutter with a new blade** - 60mm (the big one) is my favorite but any size will work
- **Medium sized rotary cutting ruler** - 6" x 12" or similar
- **12" Add-A-Quarter ruler** (yellow or pink)
- **Purple Thang** - extremely useful when sewing curves
- **Tweezers** - I like Martelli Angled Pin-Point tweezers
- **Fabric glue pen with 2 refills** (i.e., Sewline, Fons and Porter)
- **Fold template:** 3" x 12" piece of template plastic or card stock
- **Scotch tape**
- **Microtex sewing machine needles** (Size 70/10)
- **7 2-gallon zip bags**
- **~200 Jumbo (1-3/4") plastic-coated paper clips**

Fabric Requirements:

Yardages needed for the project are shown below and keyed to the fabric numbers in the graphic to the right. A note about the Lone Star units (S fabric numbers) - several fabrics are repeated in each unit.

Pre-Retreat Preparation: Please complete the following prior to coming to class.

Zip bag preparation: Label your zip bags #A1, #B1, #B2, #CR1, #CL1, #CR2 and #CL2. It can also helpful to include the pattern name or an abbreviation (TS for Twinkle Star) on the label.

Fabric preparation: Press and starch your fabrics, if desired. I like to use Faultless Heavy Starch, Lavender scent. Best Press is another great option. Cut your fabrics and place in the Zip bag indicated below.

Newsprint preparation: Unfold the 6 newsprint pages from your pattern. Trim 1/8" around the Foundation Sheets (freehand or with a rotary cutting ruler) and place in the Zip bags indicated below. Trim the Templates and Layout Sheets along the outside solid black line. Do not cut the individual units apart.
